- 1. **RESPECT YOUR TEACHER!** Please respect your teacher by not talking during rehearsals. If you have a question, please raise your hand and wait to be recognized. Raise your hand for permission to speak or leave your seat.
- 2. **RESPECT YOUR CLASSMATES!** Show respect to your classmates by not distracting them from class. Keep your hands and feet to yourself at all times.
- 3. **BE ON TIME TO CLASS!** All tardiness will be documented.
- 4. **NO GUM OR CANDY SHOULD BE OPEN DURING CLASS!** No food, drink, gum, or candy will be allowed during class.
- 5. **BRING YOUR STUFF!** Students must bring their instrument, music and a pencil to class every day and after school rehearsals.
- 6. **TAKE CARE OF YOUR STUFF!** Students are responsible for cleaning up after themselves, cleaning their instruments and putting their equipment away after every rehearsal.
- 7. **RESPECT OUR EQUIPMENT!** Your instrument is for you to play and only you. Instruments are extremely expensive, so students should never play each other's instruments. In addition, percussion instruments are only to be played by percussionists.
- 8. **BE READY AND WILLING!** When you walk into the band room, you should always be ready to work and willing to learn. I will not ask for perfection, but I will insist that you do your best.
- 9. DO NOT THROW, BOUNCE, TOSS OR KICK ANYTHING IN THE BAND ROOM! The

band parents have worked very hard to raise money for the nice equipment that we have. We do not want the equipment broken. NO RUNNING OR "HORSE PLAY" IN THE BAND ROOM

10. STUDENTS ARE NOT TO ENTER THE INSTRUMENT STORAGE ROOMS! - Students

should not enter the storage rooms without permission.

11. STUDENTS SHOULD NOT LEAVE THE BAND ROOM UNTIL THE BELL RINGS! - It

takes some longer than others to put your instruments away. If you finish first, do not leave the band room.

- 12. **HAVE FUN!** Being part of band should be fun for all students. If you try your best and meet all expectations, I am certain that this last expectation will happen all by itself!
- 13. INSTRUMENTS/MUSIC SHOULD BE STORED IN THEIR CUBBY! Do not leave

instruments or music lying around the room. All of you have/will have an assigned cubby!!!
