PBIS: What Parents Need to Know

What is PBIS?

PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports.

Positive behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a way for schools to encourage good behavior and support the needs of ALL Students.

The focus of PBIS is prevention, not punishment.

With PBIS, schools teach kids about behavior, just as they would teach about other subjects like reading or math.

This school-wide approach to discipline focuses on building a safe and positive environment in which all students can learn.

The foundation of PBIS at Everetts Elementary STEM Academy is the four buildingwide expectations:

- Respect,
- Integrity,
- Safety,
- Excellence

What is a PBIS Tiger Buck? At EESA Positive behavior is reinforced and acknowledged. Students will earn Tiger Bucks for meeting behavior expectations.







When students meet behavior goals, Tiger Bucks, Raffle Tickets, Contest, Field Trips, Game Day, Movie Day, Flavored Ice Truck, Trip to the PBIS Store, Dances, and Assemblies are some of the PBIS incentives to students or whole classes.

In addition to our behavior expectations, PBIS has four (4) other components::

1) behavior Matrix; 2) direct teaching; 3) PBIS tiger bucks; and 4) behavior tracking sheets.



Teaching Expectations

Throughout the school year, students will be taught how to behave according to the four expectations. Teachers will help students learn what the expectations "look" and "sound" like in every setting during the school day. These lessons will be re-taught and reinforced throughout the school year.

Behavior Tracking Sheet

To address inappropriate behavior, a Behavior Tracking Sheet has been implemented for major and minor infractions.

Parents/Guardians, teachers, support staff, and Administration will meet to build an effective behavior intervention plan for that child.

Behavior Matrix

The behavior matrix is a detailed description of expected behavior in each setting of the school. A matrix will be sent home with your child by the teacher.
