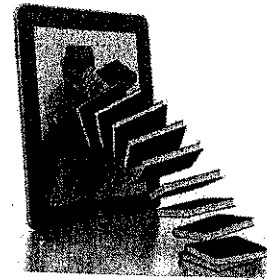




# STOP THE PRESSES...

## E-BOOKS HAVE ARRIVED AT THE HALIFAX COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM

### FROM YOUR COMPUTER:

1. Visit <https://e-inc.overdrive.com/>. This will take you to the ebook website.
2. Click the blue sign-in button.
3. On the left side of the screen, you will see a drop down box for you to select a library/library system. Click the arrow and select "Halifax County Library System". You will then be asked for your library card number and the last four digits of your phone number as it is listed in the Halifax County Library System's database. (\*You may need to contact the library to see how your number is listed, especially if you have an older card and/or changed phone numbers over the years). Enter both numbers and click the blue sign-in button.
4. Once you have signed in, you will be directed to the shelf of e-book titles that are available. There are notations at the top of each title letting you know if the book is available or if there is a wait list. If the book is available, you may download it immediately. Go to the Loans page once you borrow it. It will give you the option to read in your computer's browser or download to your e-reader. \*if you have a Kindle Fire and you wish to download into your device, it will take you to your Amazon account and you will need to sign in there as well and then simply click "get library book".

### FROM YOUR E-READER:

1. You can use the web browser and follow instructions above or you can download the Overdrive app from your device's App Store. It is a free download.
2. Once you have downloaded the app, you will be asked to sign-in with your library card number and the last 4 digits of your phone number as it is listed in the Halifax County Library System's database. (\*You may need to contact the library to see how your number is listed, especially if you have an older card and/or changed phone numbers over the years). Enter both numbers and click the blue sign-in button.
3. Once you have created the account in Overdrive, you will be directed to the shelf of e-book titles that are available. There are notations at the top of each title letting you know if the book is available or if there is a wait list. If the book is available, you may download it immediately. Go to the Loans page to download. It will then be automatically downloaded to your device's book library.

Please note for each device, there are instructions on returning each title that is borrowed. Instructions are simple and easy to follow but if there are any questions, please contact any library for assistance.
