Proposed design approach for the project including design team and consultants.</li> <li>6. Recent experience with project costs and schedules.</li> <li>7. Construction administration capabilities.</li> <li>8. Proximity to and familiarity with the area where the project is located.</li> <li>9. Record of successfully completed projects without major legal or technical problems.</li> <li>10. Other factors which may be appropriate for the project.</li> </ol> |  |
