Position: K-2 Reading Interventionist (Part-time)

Scope of Work

Interventionists will primarily support first-year (BT1) and second-year (BT2), general education K-2 teachers participating in the Wolfpack WORKS program. The interventionists will implement and assist those teachers in implementing assessments, progress monitoring, and accompanying interventions associated with Read to Achieve legislation. The interventionists will directly support students in the BT1's and BT2's classrooms with reading at least two times per week. If additional time is available, the interventionists may support students in participating BT3's classroom on a limited basis. Any personnel funded as interventionists will participate in required online professional development through Wolfpack WORKS and complete monthly logs documenting their time spent supporting BT1s and BT2s and their students in reading intervention. The interventionist will model progress monitoring and intervention activities, provide feedback and support to the beginning teachers with these activities, share and discuss data with the teachers to aid in planning and implementing interventions for students who need extra support with early reading.

Salary: \$6,000 per BT1 and BT2 (prorated throughout the school year)
