Halifax County Schools Athletic Hall of Fame

Established in 2018, the Halifax County Schools Athletic Hall of Fame provides an opportunity for the district to recognize athletes, coaches, and others for their outstanding athletic accomplishments or contributions to athletics at the district, collegiate, and professional levels.

The goal of the Hall of Fame committee is to seek, assess and select inductees into the Hall of Fame. Applications are accepted year round and reviewed and voted on by the Hall of Fame Committee yearly. The nomination criteria and voting process shall be followed as per the Hall of Fame By Laws. The Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will take place during the Alumni Games in the spring.

BY LAWS

1. Organization:

The Hall of Fame Committee shall be made up of the following individuals:

- A. Coaches
- B. School Administrator(s)
- C. Community Member
- D. District Employee
- E. PR Team Member(s)

2. <u>Nomination Process:</u>

- A. Anyone can submit nominations or applications to the Hall of Fame Committee. Download the nomination form from the Halifax County Schools website. (www.halifax.k12.nc.us). (However, you cannot nominate yourself or a relative)
- B. Nomination forms and specified supporting materials must be submitted with nomination form.
- C. For years 1 and 2 of the Hall of Fame, a maximum of 10 individuals can be inducted.
- D. For years 3 and beyond, a maximum of 5 individuals can be inducted.

3. <u>Eligibility and Criteria:</u>

A. Three Categories:

- <u>Athlete Category</u> The athlete must have graduated from high school and is eligible for consideration after a minimum of (10) years after date of graduation.
- <u>Coach Category</u> Must have been a coach in the Halifax County Schools District for a minimum of 5 years.
- <u>Team Category</u> A team is eligible after 5 years.

B. The maximum number of inducted teams will be 1 team induction per year. There will be (2) coaches per year and 8 athletes per year during years 1 and 2. During years 3 and beyond, there will be 1 coach, 4 athletes, and 1 team (if a team is nominated)

- 4. <u>Screening and Voting Process of Candidates</u>:
 - A. All applications for each category shall be screened by the committee prior to any vote.
 - B. The committee shall then vote by ranking the candidates from top to bottom with highest point value awarded to the top candidate.
 - C. In order for a vote to take place, there should be a minimum of (5) five committee members present.
 - D. All committee members must be present for the final induction vote.
