Definition of Bullying

"Bullying" means any aggressive and unwanted behavior that is intended to harm, intimidate, or humiliate the victim; involves a real or perceived power imbalance between the aggressor or aggressors and victim; and is repeated over time or causes severe emotional trauma. "Bullying" includes cyberbullying. "Bullying" does not include ordinary teasing, horseplay, argument or peer conflict.

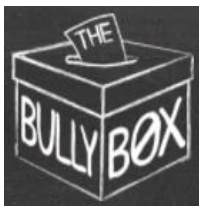
What is the Bully Box?

The Bully Box is a safe place for students to anonymously report bullying, as described above. The Bully Box provides a "voice" to those being victimized, as well as empowering up-standers, while simultaneously allowing reporters to refrain from becoming directly involved in the incident.

Making a Report!

Principal Riddick will take each Bully Box report very seriously. In short, **PLEASE REFRAIN FROM SUBMITTING FALSE REPORTS**. Any student that is found, through investigation, to make false reports may be consequence based on misrepresentation, unauthorized use of technology or information, or violation of acceptable usage policy.
