Dear District Superintendents and High School Principals,

North Carolina Independent Colleges & Universities (NCICU) is excited to announce the NCICU DIRECT ADMISSION PROGRAM for North Carolina High School seniors with a 2.8 or higher weighted GPA! I am writing on behalf of NCICU to ask you to help us reach these students so they can confirm their acceptance among the 26 NCICU campuses in this program.

Students can visit www.ncicu.org to complete a streamlined application in as little as 5 minutes with no application fee. By answering a few questions, students will hear from each of the participating colleges and universities that they have selected, with information about individual campus requirements, their conditional acceptance, and the availability of financial aid.

The Superintendent of the NC Department of Public Instruction (NCPDI) has refused to allow NCICU to send letters through NCDPI to eligible students about their direct admission to these 26 private, non-profit colleges and universities, as she is doing for a pilot with all the community colleges and 6 public universities. She has stated that, "It is our thought that a separate letter from NCICU will confuse students and parents and therefore affect the potential for a successful pilot."

NCICU strongly disagrees that letting 70,000 students know of their direct admission into 26 additional colleges and universities could be considered confusing. We believe having more acceptances to college will help students find their "right fit" and will also contribute to meeting the state's myFutureNC educational attainment goal.

Therefore, we are asking for and depending upon your assistance to inform eligible students about this new program and these tremendous college acceptances. Thank you for your help!

Lastly, I would like to encourage you to remind your students to seize the opportunities presented by the [North Carolina Need-Based Scholarship, Federal Pell Grants, and significant Institutional Aid](#) available at NCICU campuses. By prioritizing the completion of their FAFSA, students can unlock essential resources to pave the way for success in college!

Since the COVID pandemic, the percentage of North Carolina high school graduates enrolling in higher education has declined. We are committed to making college more accessible and affordable for North Carolina students and families - to increase their quality of life and to help increase educational attainment and economic development in our state.
