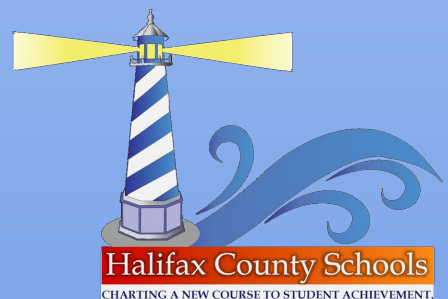

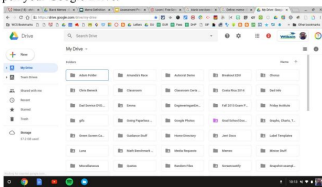
Memes

1. Open your Google Drive.



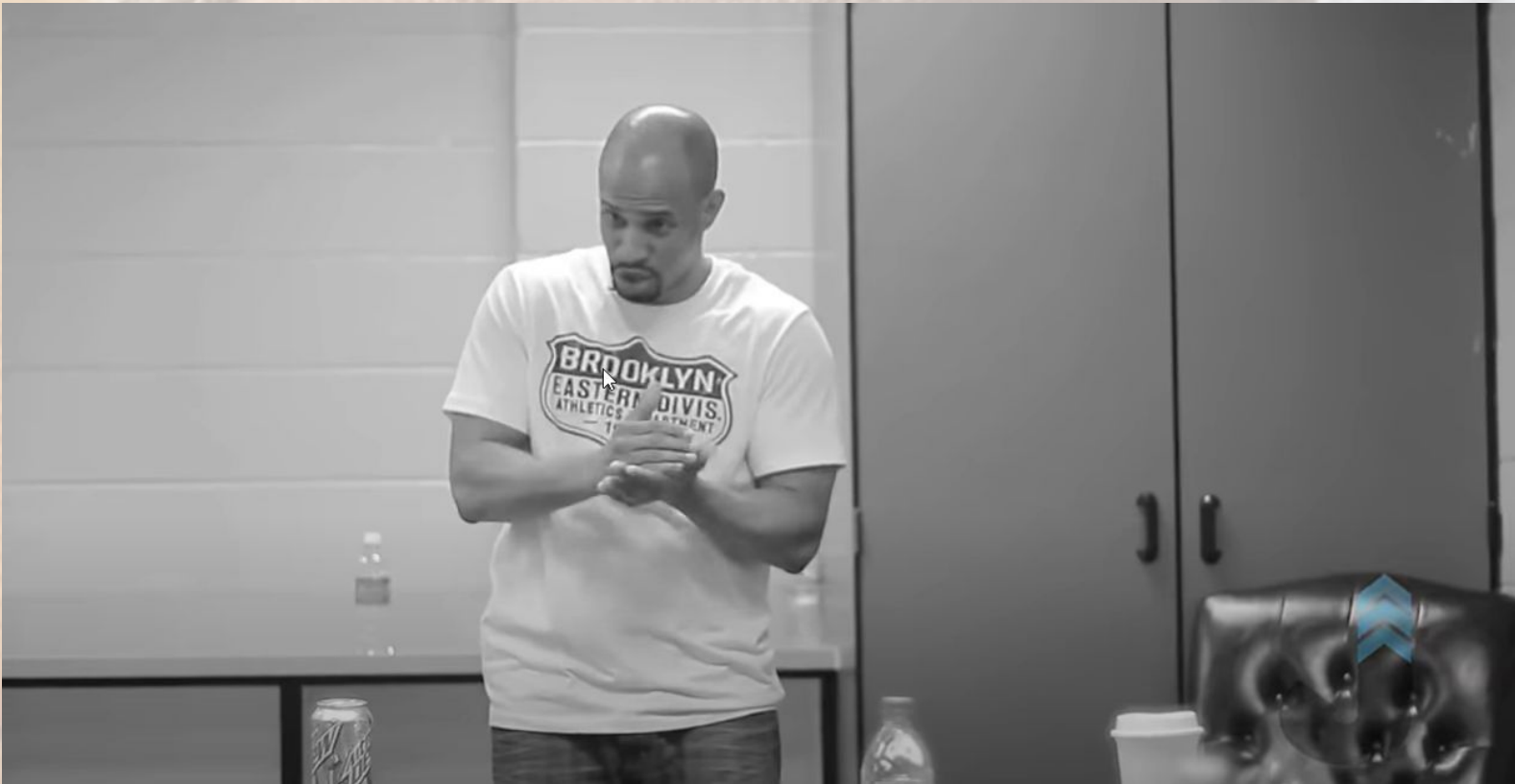

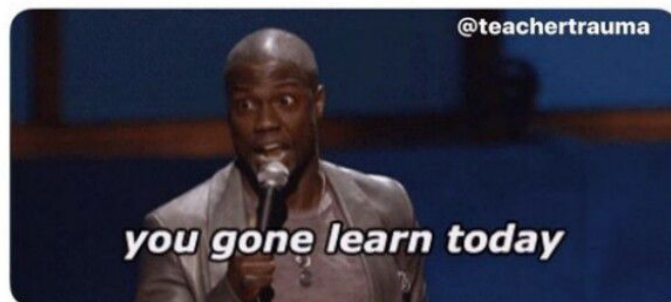
